

Nominations for the 2011 IBEA Awards are now open.

The following awards are available:

Outstanding Business Educator of the Year

Nominations for these awards may be submitted for the following individuals.

1. Outstanding Business Educator at the Elementary/Middle/Junior High School level.
2. Outstanding Business Educator at the High School level.
3. Outstanding Business Educator at the Senior College/Collegiate/University level.
4. Outstanding Business Educator at the Postsecondary level that is less than a four-year institution.

IBEA Friend of Business Education

The Friend of Business Education Award is given to an individual who does not necessarily have membership in Idaho Business Education Association. Only one award may be given each year to an individual and the presentation will be made at the IBEA Annual Conference.

Criteria for Nomination:

An individual who supports and enhances Idaho Business Education.

Distinguished Service Award

The Distinguished Service Award is the highest award presented by the Idaho Business Education Association. Only one award may be given each year to an individual, and the presentation will be made at the IBEA Annual Conference.

Criteria for Nomination

1. An individual who has served and contributed to IBEA and business education through professional activities that include leadership, service, honors and awards, and research and writing.
2. This nominee shall be a business educator who must be a member of IBEA.

Outstanding Career and Technical Student Organization Advisor

Procedures

1. Nominations may be made by any IBEA member. The nominee must also be a member of IBEA.

2. Nominations must follow the official form and procedures outlined. No additional material is to be submitted. Do not put the nomination packet in a folder. Staple the pages in the upper left corner.
3. Submit four (4) copies of the nomination packet to the IBEA Awards Director postmarked no later than MAY 23, 2011.
4. The Awards Director will notify the nominator of the nominee who will receive the IBEA award. The nominator will contact the winners' supervisors to provide support for the winner. The nominator will ensure that the winner is present at the IBEA awards ceremonies.

If a nominee is not selected for the award the first year of nomination, the papers may be considered the next year. Contact the Awards Director to request that the application be considered again. If editing is required, a new application must be submitted following the guidelines by the deadline date.

IBEA Distinguished Service Award for A Company, or Representative of a Company, or Legislator

The Distinguished Service Award for a Company, or Representative of a Company or Legislator is awarded to a company or individual who does not necessarily have membership in Idaho Business Education Association. Only one award may be given each year to an Organization, or to a Representative of an Organization, or to a Legislator and the presentation will be made at the IBEA Annual Conference.

Criteria for Nomination

A Company, or Representative of the Company, or a Legislator who has served a major portion of their business in the Western region.

IBEA Emerging Professional Business Teacher Award

ELIGIBILITY

The nominee must be primarily engaged in teaching business at the K-12 level. The nominee must have taught for five or fewer years. If the nominee has dual responsibilities, at least 50 percent of those responsibilities at the major employing institution must be in teaching. The nominee must be a member of IBEA.

NOMINATION GUIDELINES (Please read carefully.)

1. Nominations must be made by an IBEA member or by the Executive Boards of IBEA-affiliated state or local associations. The nominator signing the form must be a current IBEA member or the nominee will be disqualified.
